

Rules and Regulations: **Absolutely NO Scavenging!!!**

SOLID WASTE (HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE)

Place in the compactor only, unless instructed by the attendant to use the miscellaneous container. **Use transparent bags only.** Black or other opaque bags are not allowed.

BRUSH

Logs, stumps, limbs and branches should be placed in the designated area only. No painted or treated wood shall be disposed of in this area.

WOOD PRODUCTS

All wood products and other construction waste materials must be placed in the miscellaneous (open top) containers. No contractors or persons may deposit large amounts of debris without a permit. See the attendant for details.

COMPOST PILE

Yard waste consists of leaves, pine needles, grass clippings and garden waste. Do not mix in with any other items. Yard waste shall be free and clear of all plastics, stones, branches, plastic bags, etc. Yard waste will be accepted year around on any day the transfer site is open. **PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE THE MATERIAL IN PLASTIC BAGS – EMPTY THE BAGS AND THROW THEM AWAY.**

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS ACCEPTED!! A Hazardous Waste Collection is held every other summer at the Adams County Solid Waste site. Their next collection is scheduled for 2020 and local newspapers will announce the date. Empty latex paint cans and solidified latex paint is allowed for disposal **ONLY** if the paint is hard and dry.

NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINES, AND MIXED PAPER

Place all newsprint in the bin marked “Newspaper”. Place magazines, pop and beer cases, cereal boxes, and mixed paper in the bin marked “Magazines/office waste paper.” Do not bundle and tie.

STEEL & TIN CANS

Rinse all food and beverage cans and place in the designated bin. No need to remove the label.

BATTERIES, OIL, ETC.

An area to dispose of used oil, oil filters, oil absorbents, automotive batteries, and anti-freeze is provided. These items are accepted free of charge. The attendant will direct you to the proper location for these materials.

APPLIANCES

An area to dispose of white goods—refrigerators, microwaves, stoves, washers, dryers, air conditioners and dehumidifiers is provided. You **MUST** check with the attendant before unloading appliances. The disposal fee is \$15.00 per item, except for microwaves, which are \$10/ea.

TIRES

The charge to dispose of tires without a rim is \$3.00/ea.; with a rim is \$5.00/ea.

CEMENT & BLACKTOP

Cement and blacktop is not accepted at the Transfer Site.

SCRAP METAL

NO rusted burn barrels, woven or barbed wire, fuel tanks or wood is allowed in the scrap metal area. No large parts, vehicle toppers, or trailers. Any large items shall be disposed of at local scrap yards. If in doubt, ASK!

CARDBOARD

Flatten boxes and cut to 3 foot x 3 foot pieces. Place in the bin marked "Cardboard." Do not bundle or tie. Pop and beer cases and cereal boxes are to be placed in the mixed paper recycling bin.

GLASS BOTTLES/JARS

Accept food and beverage glass bottles and jars only. Remove caps and lids and discard. Place glass in the designated bin. Do not accept auto glass, window glass, light bulbs, or ceramics.

PLASTIC BOTTLES & CONTAINERS

Accept all plastic bottles, jugs and containers. Rinse and replace plastic caps and lids. Discard **plastic containers used for anti-freeze, fuel, or motor oil in the trash compactor.**

LIGHT BULBS

4' florescent - \$.75 each; 8' florescent - \$1.25 each; 4' shielded florescent - \$2.25 each; 8' shielded florescent - \$3.25 each; heavy weight incandescent (spotlights, floodlights) - \$1.00 each; regular household bulbs - \$0.50 each; household CFL bulbs - \$0.75 each; ultra violet - \$2.25 each; high intensity discharge (mercury vapor, etc.) - \$6.50 each.

SHARPS

DO NOT DISPOSE OF SHARPS WITH YOUR GARBAGE OR RECYCLING!! Dispose of your sealed and labeled sharps container at Aspirus Riverview Hospital at the main entrance on the east side of the complex. Additionally, Adams County Solid Waste offers small sharps containers available for \$5.00 and large sharps containers for \$10.00. This charge includes the disposal.

COMPUTERS/TV/ELECTRONICS

We currently accept electronics at the Transfer Site. These items can be placed in the open top container Placed near the office (charges may apply). We currently charge \$15 for all TVs, computer monitors, or lap tops. Other than these specified items, all other electronic items are currently accepted free of charge.

WOOD, BRUSH, YARD WASTE

Accepted any day the Transfer Site is open.

MATTRESSES

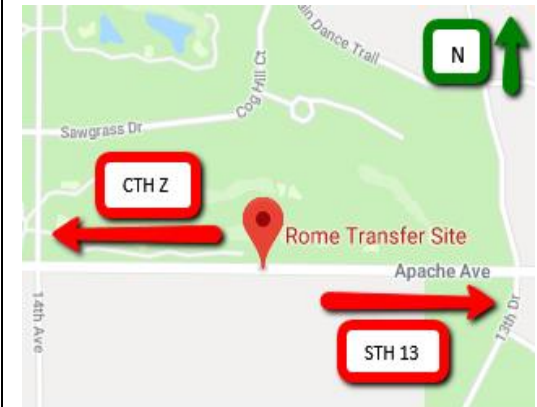
Crib/Twin \$5.00; all other sizes \$10. Box spring is considered a mattress.
